1. Avery County - Avery Soil and Water - Calloway Creek Dam Removal and Restoration \$153,000

This project will remove an in-stream earthen dam from Calloway Creek and restore 1,100 feet of stream channel through the former impounded area.

2. Buncombe County – Buncombe Soil and Water - Swannanoa 4H Education Center \$3,300

This project will construct a stormwater harvesting and bioretention system at the Swannanoa 4H Education Center, which will be used in the Center's student education curricula and as a demonstration site for visitors and conference attendees.

3. Carteret County – Town of Morehead City - Morehead City Bulkhead Channel Study \$20,000

This project will determine the location for a repositioned harbor line by developing a master plan for the Morehead City Bulkhead Channel.

4. Dare County – Town of Manteo - Manteo Stormwater Outfalls \$45,000

This project will design three Shallowbag Bay stormwater outfall retrofits and install one of them.

5. Haywood County - Lake Junaluska Sediment Removal Phase 1 \$150,000

This is Phase 1 of a project to remove 22,000 cubic yards of spoil material from the lake and to construct on-site impoundments for material disposal.

6. Onslow County - Onslow County Waterway Project Phase 3 \$78,378

This project is the last phase in an effort to remove significant flow blockages and small-boat navigation hazards from over 100 miles of stream throughout Onslow County.

7. Wake County - Mingo Creek Master Plan \$15,000

This project will identify and evaluate stormwater drainage problems in the Mingo Creek watershed, which encompasses 43 percent of the existing limits of the Town of Knightdale.

8. Wilkes County – Town of Wilkesboro - Cub Creek Park Stabilization Phase 2 \$167,000

This project will stabilize 3,000 feet of streambank along Cub Creek and an unnamed tributary; both located within the Town's Cub Creek Park.

9. Wilkes County - Town of North Wilkesboro - Yadkin River Greenway \$197,400

This project will construct a 6,000-foot linear foot trail along the Yadkin River that will connect three North Wilkesboro parks and eventually extend to Kerr Scott Reservoir.
