

Local Water Supply Plans & Water Shortage Response Planning

In effort to meet the needs of our water systems, the North Carolina Rural Water Association (NCRWA) and the NC DENR Water Resources Division are pleased to present a one day (6 contact hours) seminar on Local Water Supply Plans (LWSPs) and Water Shortage Response Planning. By examining current and future needs, LWSPs allow local governments to better manage water supplies, plan for water supply system improvements, and prepare for a variety of water shortage situations. Planning at the local level is the best place to address and respond to water shortages. All units of local government that provide or plan to provide public water service and all community water systems serving 1,000 or more connections or more than 3,000 people in North Carolina are required to prepare and submit a LWSP, as mandated by NC General Statute 143-355 (l). Updated LWSPs are required at least every five years. Beginning in 2007, a staggered reporting schedule was adopted. Water systems located in the Neuse and Roanoke River basins submitted updated plans based on 2006 calendar year conditions by June 2007; all other systems must update their plans according to 2007 conditions by July 1, 2008.

There is no charge for this seminar; however, pre-registration is required to reserve a seat and for planning purposes. NCRWA and DENR staffs look forward to seeing you at the seminar.
