State cancels river basin meeting due to weather conditions

RALEIGH – Due to weather conditions, officials have canceled Friday’s meeting aimed at helping start the state’s process of evaluating water supplies in the Roanoke River Basin.

The meeting had been scheduled for Rockingham Community College. A makeup date and location will be announced soon.

The state agency is holding meetings to start developing a water resources plan and a hydrologic model that can be used by planners, developers and county officials in the Roanoke River basin. The plans help state and other officials evaluate water supplies in the river basin and determine if there will be enough water in the basin to satisfy future users under all types of hydrologic conditions.

The Roanoke River Basin spans parts of 19 counties on or near the Virginia border, including parts of Rockingham, Stokes and Caswell counties. On Monday, state officials held their first meeting on the Roanoke River basin planning process at Halifax Community College.
