Summary Description Of Proposed Activity: The permit applicant, Mr. William K Brooks of William K. Brooks Sand & Gravel Pit located approximately .3 miles southeast of the intersection of Mail Route Rd and Lucas Lane, Wallace, NC, proposes to withdraw and use a maximum of 960,000 gallons of ground water per day in Duplin County. Water withdrawals will be from one sump in the Surficial aquifer for the purpose of mine dewatering. The withdrawn water will be disposed of ditches that drain to Rockfish Creek (NPDES permit # NCG02).
