


Greenville Utilities Commission

- Plans to sell water to Towns of Farmville and Winterville and Greene County
- Result in two interbasin transfers from the Tar River basin
- Allow Farmville, Winterville and Greene County to comply with the Central Coastal Plain Capacity Use Area rules.

Greenville Utilities Commission IBT Petition Timeline

- October 2008: Final EA submitted and a FONSI received.
- April 2009: IBT petition submitted to DWR
- May 2009: Request EMC approval to take Petition to public hearings

Old Rules: GS 143-215.22I

- Repealed in August 2007
- Applicable for IBT Petitions to supplement ground water supplies in the CCPCUA's 15 counties
- Completion prior to January 1, 2011

Recommendations

- That the Environmental Management Commission approve DWR's request to schedule a public hearing on GUC's IBT petition.
- That this public hearing be held later in 2009, after giving at least 30 days' written notice of the hearing.
